

Scrap Metal will be Collected at Claymont “Green Day” Event

As a participant in the annual Claymont “Green Day” community clean-up event on **Saturday, June 12, 2010**, Evraz Claymont Steel invites neighbors to bring unwanted scrap metal and mercury-containing household items for appropriate and safe recycling.

Recycling bins will be located next to the **Claymont Community Center** at 3301 Green Street from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m.** where steelworks employees will be on hand to assist neighbors with the safe deposit of scrap metal and unwanted household items that contain mercury.

The following metal objects will be accepted for recycling: steel furniture, shelving and racking systems, bicycle frames, machine parts, structural steel, steel pipe and fencing, car and truck rims (with lead weights removed), and automotive parts (with all free liquids removed such as motor oil, transmission fluid).

As a community service, the following household items containing mercury will also be accepted for recycling: thermometers, barometers, mercuric oxide button batteries, thermostats, and mercury blood pressure measuring units. Bring only objects that have the mercury container (glass tube, glass or metal capsule, etc.) intact with no leakage. Visit the U.S. [EPA](#) website for proper instructions in handling and transporting objects with mercury.

Below find a full list of items that will be accepted and those not to bring.

In addition to collecting recyclables, more than 50 employees of Evraz Claymont Steel will participate as volunteers in the Claymont Green Day street clean-up effort. Employees and their families will collect roadside debris starting at the plant borders on Naaman’s Road and continue along Philadelphia Pike to the I-495 Interchange. The company will have a display booth on the Claymont Community Center lawn where the public can learn about scrap recycling and the steel making process.

Employee volunteers will be on hand to help you with your drop off between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Acceptable METAL Items:

- Steel furniture
- Shelving and racking systems
- Bicycle frames (no tires or rubber handlebar grips)
- Machine parts
- Structural steel
- Steel pipe and fencing
- Car and truck rims with lead weights removed
- Automotive parts with all free liquids removed – e.g., motor oil, transmission fluid.

Acceptable MERCURY Household Items:

- Thermometers
- Thermostats
- Barometers
- Mercuric oxide button batteries
- Mercury blood pressure units.

For the Safety of our employees and the environment, we are unable to accept the following items:

Unacceptable Items:

- Any leaking or open mercury containers or objects.
- Closed containers – e.g., propane bottles (gas grill, hand torch, or camp stove bottles), paint cans, aerosol cans, and shock absorbers.
- Free liquids – e.g., oil, paint, solvents, cleaners, etc. or materials containing free liquids, e.g., motor crankcases.
- Refrigerators or freezers containing refrigerants. These items need to be certified that they have been drained and must be delivered to another scrap recycling facility.
- Lead – e.g., batteries, pipe joints, wheel lugs, fishing sinkers.
- Concrete – Any material that has attached concrete, e.g., fence post and parking lot bumpers.
- Plastics or any type of steel with plastics attached.
